What is the tool?

The Implementing Centers tool is a mechanism for communities to assess barriers to development of higher density, mixed use centers and develop strategies to overcome these barriers.

Components:

- The Community Development Guidebook helps the user better understand proper development, barriers to it, and strategies to overcome those barriers. It provides a plan for the community to allow and welcome positive development
- The three Pre-Development Checklists allow you to specify the process to your area in question.

What is the objective?

The objective of this tool is for users to go into the visioning, planning, and development process having taken all of the appropriate steps before hand. The Implementing Centers tool ensures confidence that the correct measures have been taken to identify the full potential of the site.

What does the tool require?


